- a sustainable production and use of marine and landbased natural resources.
- a cross sectorial approach based on a circular economy

The EU strategy for the Baltic Sea Region

- a way to develop a non fossil based economy
- an economy based on the photosynthesis and with industrial processes to use the natural materials as optimal and <u>circular</u> as possible
- Contributes directly to many of the UN Sustainable Development Goals in Agenda 2030




Bioeconomy creates global well-being Value from forest, water and waste






Fossil based electricity production in the EU

- Upgrading plant materials to high-value products, BioValue SPIR / Denmark






The biomass of the mammals consists of:




