15 regional energy agencies

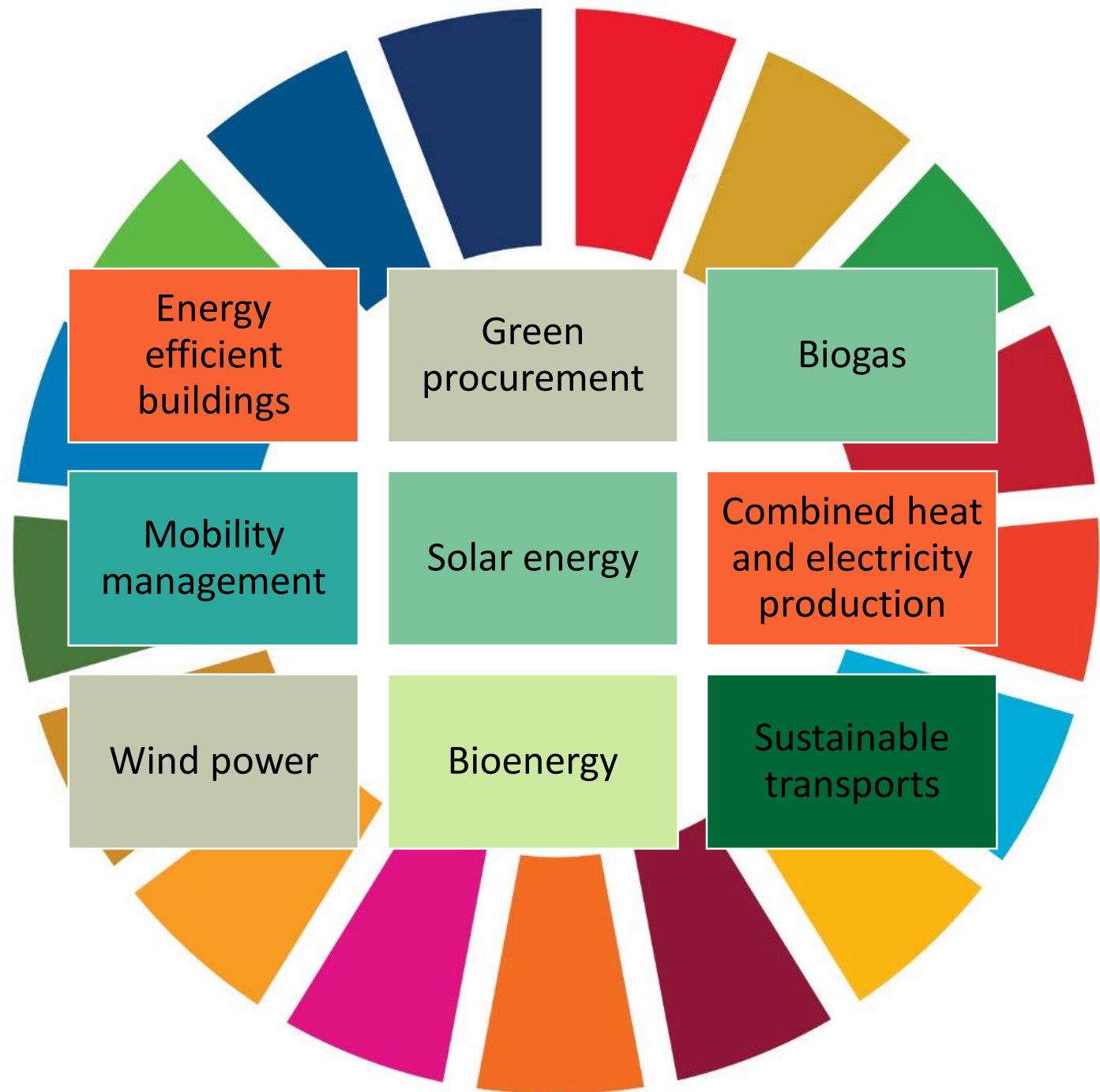
Europe:

- The agency provides the region around 25 energy experts
- Works in collaboration with both private operators and public bodies
- We are a non-profit company
- Our areas of expertise includes biogas, energy efficiency in buildings, wind power, solar energy, transport logistics, circular economy, as well as dissemination and networking, among other things.

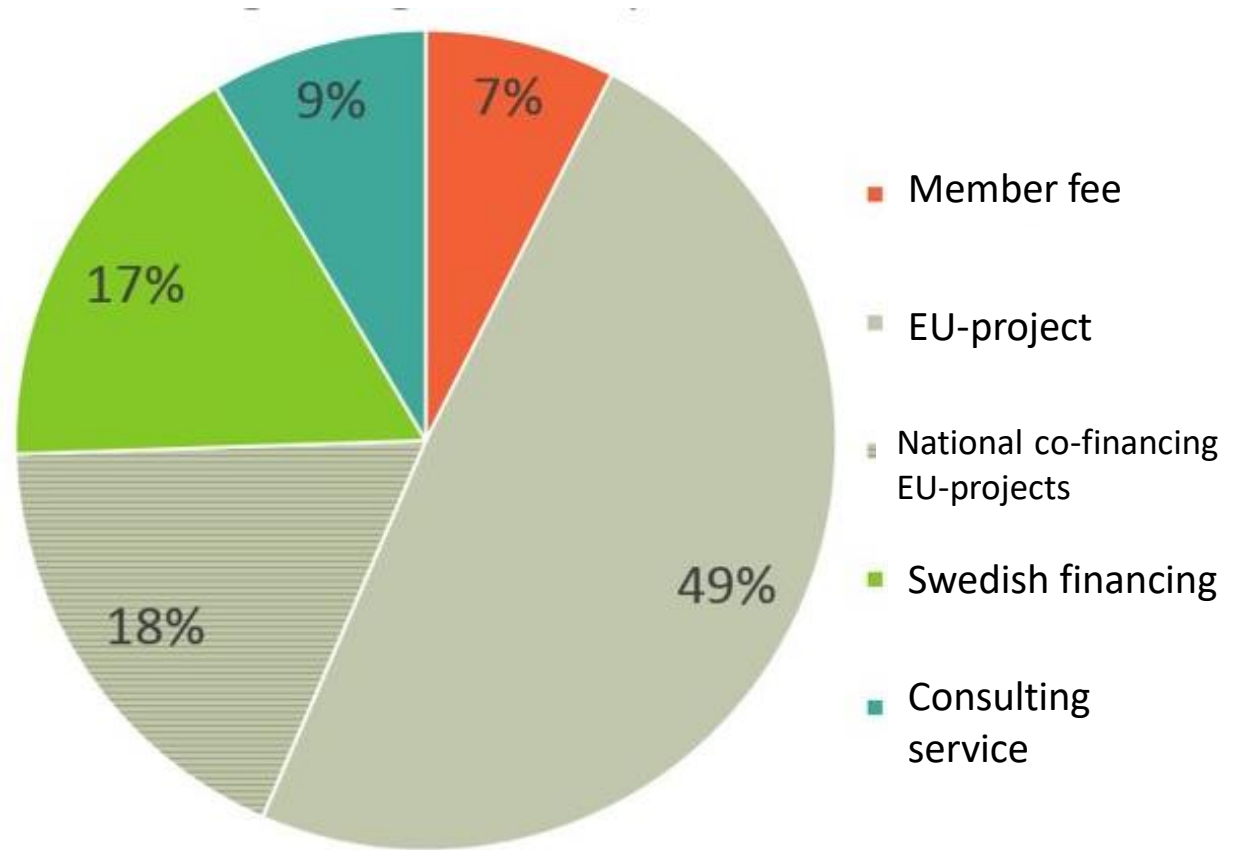


Funding and benefits for the region of the agency

Southeast Sweden: 5-10% of the annual turnover is member fee

60-70% is funded by EU-programmes incl
swedish co-financing

Result: The region Southeast Sweden receives extra resources for energy and climate work worth approx **10 times** the initial funding

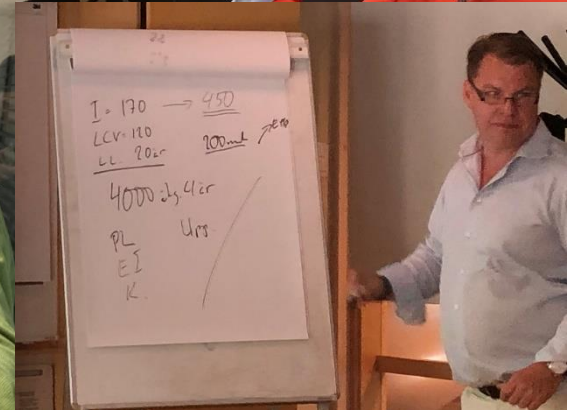
Project example: energy efficiency

Purpose: as a regional energy agency we **support local and regional authorities** of exploring good practices on **dynamically monitoring energy efficiency in buildings**, with special focus on the use of innovative financial instruments, in order to achieve more carbon reduction.

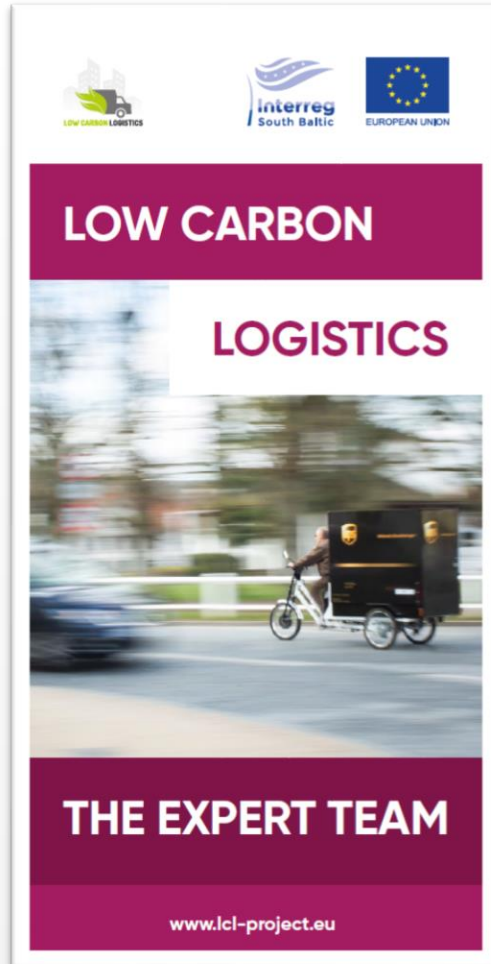
