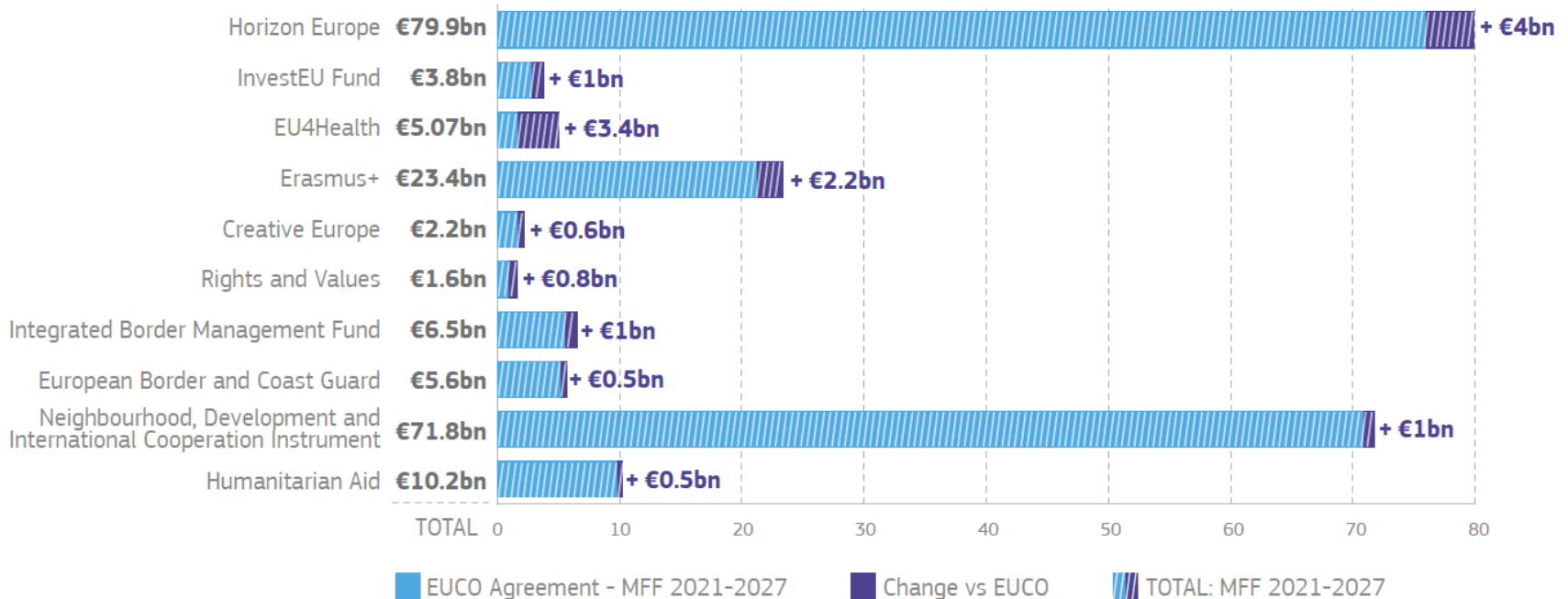
MFF 2021-2027

- First proposal from the EC in May 2018
- New priorities emerged Q1 2020
- Adjusted proposal from the EC in May 2020
- Negotiations between European Council & European Parliament – deal reached on 10/11 → **1,8 trillion EUR** (largest ever EU budget) comprising:
 - ✓ **1.074 trillion of „regular” long-term budget**
 - ✓ **€750 billion for NextGenerationEU**

NEW MFF is all about **EUROPE** that is:

- **more resilient** (post-COVID recovery)
- **greener**
- **more digital**

Within the long-term budget 2021-2027, **ten programmes received top-ups** compared to the European Council agreement from 21 July 2020.



NEW MFF – priorities & funding instruments

50% + of the BUDG will go to:

- ✓ **modernisation** through policies that include R&I, via **Horizon Europe**;
- ✓ fair climate and digital transitions, via the **Just Transition Fund** and the **Digital Europe programme**;
- ✓ preparedness, recovery and resilience, via the **Recovery and Resilience Facility, rescEU** and a new health programme **EU4Health**
- **30%** of the BUDG will be devoted to **climate mainstreaming**
- „traditional” policies (**cohesion, agriculture**) with significant EU budget funds (mainstreamed towards **green and digital transitions**)

HOT DECEMBER IN BRUSSELS

- threat of veto affirmed by PL&HUN
- firm institutional position: no EU money for a MS that does not observe the rule of law
- several scenarios possible if the obstruction persists
- 10-11 December – summit of the European Council
